This initiative aims to promote healthy lifestyles and provide a fantastic opportunity for students to engage in physical activity. ### **GENERAL DRESS CODE (Applicable to All Students):**

- **Uniform:** Must wear the full school uniform, neatly ironed.
- Black shoes are required, however during the rainy season, black sandals are permitted.
- **House Uniform:** On Wednesdays, house uniforms must be worn with black shoes.
- **Watches:** Fancy and smart watches are discouraged.

### **Boys' Specific Dress Code:**

- Hair must be kept short and neatly combed.
- Earrings are not allowed for boys unless they are a required part of their caste or religious practice.
- Fancy haircuts and hair coloring are not permitted.
- Boys of higher classes should come with shaven faces.

**Trousers: Only formal trousers with pleats are permitted. Low waist and tight trousers are not allowed.**

### **Girls' Specific Dress Code:**

- Only black hair bands and hair clips are permitted.
- Only small ear studs are allowed. No other jewellery is permitted.
- Hair and nail coloring is strictly prohibited.
- Pinafore length must be below the knee. Petticoats and black tights are mandatory. Tights must not be visible below the pinafore.

## UNIFORM

The school uniform cloth, badge, socks and belt can be purchased from textile shop, **Reebas Tripunithura** (Near Kizhakkekota). The uniform pattern for stitching will remain the same.

### GENERAL UNIFORM PATTERN :

#### GIRLS

Std I to Std VI - Shirt and Pinafore  
Std VII to Std XII - Churidar and overcoat

#### BOYS

Std I to Std VI - Shirt and shorts  
Std VII to Std XII - Shirt and pants

N.B: Boys above 150cm are expected to wear pants irrespective of the class he studies. Given above is only a general pattern, the design of the same is available in school office}

- Black shoes



### STD.VII TO X GIRLS

- Umbrella cutting with no slits
- Loose churidar pants
- Sleeve must be at least 15 cm in length



### STD XI GIRLS

- Umbrella cutting with no slits
- Loose churidar pants
- Sleeve must be at least 15 cm in length



### STD.VII TO X BOYS

- Shirt and Pant
- Low waist and tight pants are not allowed



### STD XI BOYS

- Shirt and black pants
- Black shoes
- White socks
- Black belt
